DISCUSSION

The SIP Status Report provides the Board with a monthly update on the status of rule development activities and further study measures implementing the Bay Area 2001 Ozone Attainment Plan. Attached are an updated "SIP Rule Development Calendar" and an updated "SIP Further Study Calendar."

Measures SS-13 (surface preparation solvents) and SS-14 (solvent cleaning) were adopted at the October 16, 2002 hearing, and SS-12 (storage tanks) is scheduled for a final hearing on November 20, 2002. With adoption of these rule amendments, all measures scheduled for adoption in 2002 will have been completed.

The further study schedule has been updated to reflect activity during October. The scheduled completion date for further study technical assessment documents remains December 2002.
