**SUBJECT: BAY AREA AIR QUALITY PLAN REVISIONS**

The plans for improving air quality in the Bay Area will be updated during 2003 and early 2004. We want your input.

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District, in conjunction with the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and the Association of Bay Area Governments, will be updating plans for reducing ground-level ozone in the Bay Area in order to meet national and State air quality standards. These plans aim to reduce emissions of ozone-forming pollutants from transportation sources, industrial facilities, commercial processes and other sources.

We seek your input on strategies for reducing emissions of pollutants that form ozone (reactive organic gases and oxides of nitrogen). All suggestions will be evaluated for their potential to reduce pollution and for feasibility.



If you have ideas about organizations or individuals who should receive these notices, or other suggestions about the public involvement process, we invite your comments on these issues as well.
