Agenda topics will include the Ozone Strategy, DEIR, national 8-hr ozone planning (ARB), and upcoming Air District grant programs.

The Air District, in cooperation with MTC and the ABAG, has released the public review draft of the Bay Area 2005 Ozone Strategy and Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR). The 2005 Ozone Strategy is a comprehensive document that describes the Bay Area's strategy for compliance with State one-hour ozone standard planning requirements, and is a significant component of our region's commitment to achieving clean air to protect the public's health and the environment. The strategy aims to reduce emissions of ozone-forming pollutants from transportation sources, industrial facilities, commercial processes and other sources. The DEIR examines potential secondary adverse environmental impacts that might result from implementation of control measures included in the 2005 Ozone Strategy.

We seek your comments on the Draft Ozone Strategy and DEIR and are providing these two upcoming public meetings for your input. Written comments on the proposed Bay Area 2005 Ozone Strategy will be received until 5 pm, Nov. 9, 2005 and on the DEIR until 5 pm, Nov. 21, 2005.

We recommend taking transit. Both locations are accessible by BART (Lake Merritt & Richmond stations) and by AC Transit.

The Draft Ozone Strategy and DEIR are both available on-line.
