The TCM Workshop on September 30 was intended to provide Ozone Working Group participants with an opportunity to review MTC's progress on TCM evaluation as well as to suggest new strategies that may not yet have been considered (see attached Agenda). The accompanying powerpoint presentation, used at the Workshop, includes information on existing TCMs, TCM suggestions from the public, new travel information obtained from recent MTC surveys, initial estimates of the motor vehicle emission inventory in 2006, and some preliminary analysis of selected TCMs.

Next Steps

MTC continues to evaluate TCM suggestions related to their potential for inclusion in federal and state ozone plans and will develop a report to present the results. The report would include information used to calculate emission reductions for a variety of measures, definitions of de minimus levels, and the final Reasonably Available Control Measure (RACM) analysis when it is completed. The target date for completion of the report has not yet been determined.

Purpose of the workshop: Federal and state air quality plans for ozone are being updated, and discussion of new control strategies is taking place at the Ozone Working Group meetings hosted by the Air District, ABAG, and MTC. As part of this process, MTC is considering new transportation control strategies to reduce motor vehicle emissions. This workshop will provide an additional opportunity for those interested in Transportation Control Measures to learn about the results of the evaluation to date and make additional suggestions for consideration.
