PUBLIC WORKSHOP – DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION 3: FEES AND REGULATION 5:

OPEN BURNING

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (District) will conduct a series of public workshops to review and discuss draft amendments, specific to open burning, to District Regulation 3: Fees and Regulation 5: Open Burning. The scheduled locations/times for these workshops are shown below in Attachment A.

The draft proposed amendments to Regulation 3 would establish open burning fees by adding a new fee schedule, Schedule V. The goal of the draft fee amendments is to increase fee revenue to recover 85% the estimated costs of the District's Open Burning Program. The recovery of regulatory program costs is consistent with the District's Cost Recovery Policy.

The following new fees would be added:

- <u>Prior District Notification Fee</u> This fee would apply to the twelve (12) allowable fire types in Regulation 5 which require burners to provide notification to the District prior to burning.
- Wildland Vegetation Management Fire (Prescribed Burning) Fee This fee would apply to all prescribed burning projects and those fires that, by definition in Regulation 5, are regulated as Wildland Vegetation Management fires.
- Marsh Management Fire (Marsh Burning) Fee The fee would be determined for each property and be based on the proposed acreage to be burned.
- <u>Stubble Fire (Stubble Burning) Fee</u> This fee would apply to stubble burners required by Regulation 5 to receive an acreage burning allocation prior to burning. The fee would be determined for each property and be based on the proposed acreage to be burned.
- <u>Filmmaking and Public Exhibition Fire Fee</u> An operations fee for burners required to submit a petition to the District for approval prior to burning.

In addition, the following provisions are proposed in Regulation 3, Schedule V:

- All fees would be non-refundable.
- All fees would be paid "up front" prior to burning.
