

**Questions and Answers – RFP 2015-007 IT and Telecom Infrastructure Implementation**

1. Is there a separate requirement for the Layer 1 Copper/Fiber building infrastructure since this is our area of expertise?

Structured cabling between servers and patching to IDF networks is part of the work required under this RFP. Vendors may bid for any portion of the RFP, or approach other vendors to act as a subcontractor on any proposal submitted under this RFP.

There is no building infrastructure cabling for connectivity to MPOE, connectivity from IDF switches to workstations or for connectivity from core switches to IDF switches under this RFP.

2. We are curious to know if you are willing to seriously consider a non-NetApp response to your RFP?

All vendors are encouraged to bid on any part or all parts of the proposal in an approach that the vendor considers optimal. Although alternative materials and/or services may be considered, the District has a preference for the services and materials listed in the RFP.
