Summary of Board of Directors **Budget and Finance Committee Meeting** Wednesday, January 22, 2014

1. Call to Order - Roll Call

Budget and Finance Committee (Committee) Chairperson Carole Groom called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

2. **Public Comment Period:** There were no requests for public comment.

3. **Approval of Minutes of August 5, 2013**

4. Air District Financial Audit Report – Fiscal Year Ending (FYE) 2013

Jeff McKay, Deputy Air Pollution Control Officer, introduced Peggy Vande Vooren, CPA, Gilbert Associates, Inc., who gave the auditor presentation regarding the Air District Financial Audit Report for FYE 2013, including reviews of the Financial Audit Report of the Air District's Financial Statements for the FYE 2013 and the Financial Audit Report of the Office of Budget and Management Circular A-133, both unqualified reports with no reportable conditions.

The Committee and staff discussed the increase in reserves in FYE 2012.

Ms. Vande Vooren continued the presentation.

NOTED PRESENT: Board Chairperson Miley was noted present at 9:46 a.m.

The Committee and staff discussed the impact of payments to creditors by Lehman Brothers Holdings, Inc., (Lehman) and the state of Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) as of June 30, 2013.

NOTED PRESENT: Committee Vice-Chairperson Mar was noted present at 9:50 a.m.

Ms. Vande Vooren concluded the presentation.

Committee Comments:

The Committee and staff discussed what, if any, items of concern were identified by the auditor and how unpaid obligations regarding pension funding compare to other special districts.

Public Comments: None.

Committee Action: None; receive and file.

5. Second Quarter Financial Report –FYE 2014

Mr. McKay introduced Stephanie Osaze, Finance Manager of Administrative Services, who gave the staff presentation *Second Quarter Financial Report – Fiscal Year Ending 2014*, including overviews of general fund revenues, expenses and fund balances; a year-to-year comparison and summaries of purchasing reporting requirements; and cumulative vendor payments in excess of \$70.000.

The Committee and staff discussed interest revenue and the contribution to the same from Lehman payments.

Ms. Osaze continued the presentation.

The Committee and staff discussed whether the increase in asbestos fees would be best characterized as seasonal or a sign of the economy improving and the unintended consequences of prolonged drought on the pace of future development.

Ms. Osaze concluded the presentation.

Committee Comments:

The Committee and staff discussed the absence of the water bill from the presentation, the viability of alternatives to the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CALPERS) healthcare plans, the difficulties of incentivizing good health under CALPERS, the idea of self-insurance, insurance expenses generally, and methods for organizational motivation of good employee health.

6. Air District Financial Overview

Mr. McKay gave the staff presentation *Air District Financial Overview*, including a review of the status of the prior fiscal year, a mid-year summary of FYE 2014, and a review of the budget topics and highlights for the upcoming FYE 2015 budget process.

The Committee and staff discussed the seeming increase in property tax apportionments.

Mr. McKay continued the presentation.

The Committee and staff discussed a potentially erroneous payment to the Air District in the amount of \$1.7 million, how best to address it, and how reserve level targets are set.

Mr. McKay continued the presentation.

The Committee and staff discussed minimum reserve levels, benchmarks, use of surplus funds, contributions to OPEB, the headquarters move to 375 Beale Street, staff labor negotiations, and the implications of a prolonged drought.

Mr. McKay continued the presentation.

The Committee and staff discussed the distribution of employment vacancies between the Air District divisions, the shared services goal that is part of the move to 375 Beale Street, the vendor contract with Accenture to analyze shared services opportunities, the legislative agenda of California State Senator Mark DeSaulnier, whether more Enforcement staff are needed to support the Spare the Air Days program, and the desire for strategic staffing to prevent lost revenue as well as missed opportunities to distribute grant funds.

Mr. McKay continued the presentation.

Draft Minutes – Budget and Finance Committee Meeting of January 22, 2014

The Committee and staff discussed the CALPERS retirement obligation, the staff contribution percentage and the likelihood it will be a topic during labor negotiations, and the projected CALPERS contributions and their budgetary impact.

Re: Proposed Amendment to Regulation 3: Fees

RECOMMENDED ACTION

None; receive and file.

BACKGROUND

Staff develops amendments to the Air District's fee regulation as a part of the budget preparation process. On March 7, 2012, the Board of Directors adopted a Cost Recovery Policy that established a goal of increasing fee revenue sufficient to achieve 85% recovery of regulatory program costs by Fiscal Year Ending (FYE) 2016. Air District staff estimated that in order to achieve this goal, fee revenue will need to be increased by approximately 6.4% per year between FYE 2013 and 2016.

DISCUSSION

Consistent with the cost recovery policy, draft amendments to specific fee schedules were made in consideration of cost recovery analyses conducted at the fee schedule-level, with larger increases being proposed for the schedules that have larger cost recovery gaps.

Existing fee schedules would be amended as follows:

- 2% increase for fee schedules that are recovering greater than 95% of costs.
- 7% increase for fee schedules that are recovering 85% to 95% of costs.
- 8% increase for fee schedules that are recovering 75% to 84% of costs.
- 9% increase for fee schedules that are recovering less than 75% of costs.

Several fees that are administrative in nature (permit application filing fees, alternative compliance plan fees, and permit to operate renewal processing fees) would be increased by 3%.

In addition, proposed amendments to Schedule T: Greenhouse Gases would increase the fee rate from \$0.048 to \$0.09 per metric ton of carbon dioxide equivalent (CDE) emissions. This fee increase is intended to fund stationary source programs necessary to implement Board Climate Protection Resolution No. 2013-11.

Air District staff will provide the committee with additional details regarding the draft fee amendments at the committee meeting on March 26, 2014. A summary of public comments received to date, including those received at a public workshop held on February 18, 2014 will be provided.

BUDGET CONSIDERATION/FINANCIAL IMPACT

The draft fee amendments would increase fee revenue in FYE 2015 by an estimated \$2.7 million from revenue that would otherwise result without a fee increase. Fee revenue estimates will be included in the draft FYE 2015 budget.

BACKGROUND

At the March 19, 2014 Regular Board of Directors meeting, the FYE 2015 Proposed Budget document was referred to the Budget and Finance Committee for review at the Committee's March 26, 2014 meeting.

DISCUSSION

Air District staff will present the Proposed Budget for FYE 2015. The Proposed Budget is balanced, without the use of any reserves.

Air District staff will publish, prior to April 21, 2014, a notice to the general public that the first of two public hearings on the budget will be conducted on May 21, 2014 and that the second hearing will be conducted on June 4, 2014. Staff requests that the Budget and Finance Committee complete its review and take action on the Proposed Budget at the April 23, 2014 Budget and Finance Committee meeting. This will allow staff the necessary time required to amend, if necessary, the budget for the first public hearing to be held on May 21, 2014.

BUDGET CONSIDERATION/FINANCIAL IMPACT

The proposed consolidated budget for FYE 2014 is a balanced budget.
