

DR. STEPHEN SCHNEIDER BIO

Dr. Stephen H. Schneider was Professor of Environmental Biology and Global Change at Stanford University, a Co-Director at the Center for Environment Science and Policy of the Freeman Spogli Institute for International Studies and a Senior Fellow in the Stanford Woods Institute for the Environment. He served as a consultant to Federal Agencies and advised every president from Nixon to Obama on environmental issues.



His research included modeling of the atmosphere, climate change, and "the relationship of biological systems to global climate change." Dr. Schneider was the founder and editor of the journal *Climatic Change* and authored or co-authored over 450 scientific papers and other publications. He was a Coordinating Lead Author in Working Group II IPCC TAR and was engaged as a co-anchor of the Key Vulnerabilities Cross-Cutting Theme for the Fourth Assessment Report (AR4) at the time of his death. During the 1980s, he emerged as a leading public advocate of sharp reductions of greenhouse gas emissions to combat global warming. He recognized the need to understand how to community the science surrounding greenhouse gas emissions and global climate change.

AWARD DESCRIPTION & PURPOSE

The Dr. Stephen Schneider Climate Leadership Award, sponsored by the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, will be presented annually to an individual, business, organization, educational institution or agency for leading successful environmental projects and establishing climate protection efforts in the areas of advocacy, education and emission reductions.

The Dr. Stephen Schneider Climate Leadership Award is designed to bring about a greater knowledge and awareness of effective climate protection practices and projects. It recognizes those individuals or organizations that make outstanding contributions to leading climate change initiatives, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and conducting environmental educational programs within the Bay Area region. The Bay Area hosts a wealth of individuals, organizations and businesses who are addressing environmental challenges. This award is meant to recognize their efforts.





MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Nominee must be a resident, business, government, academic or non-profit organization located in the 9-county Bay Area region.
- The specified program, project or initiative must have been successfully implemented within the past three years.
- The Air District strongly encourages the nomination of all individuals and organizations who have not previously been recognized through this program.
