Stubble and Straw Burning Ends December 31, 2007

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District's (Air District) fall permissive burn season for disposal of Stubble and Straw officially ends on December 31, 2007.

Stubble and Straw burning can only take place between specified dates according to the Air District's open burning regulation (Regulation 5). The regulation can be downloaded at www.baaqmd.gov.
