Flood debris burning season closes May 31

SAN FRANCISCO - The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is announcing the close of the permissible burn season for flood debris within the Bay Area effective Saturday, May 31, 2008.

Set for the purpose of removing wood and vegetation debris deposited by floodwaters, flood debris fires can only take place on a burn day as determined by the Air District.
