Air District targets greenhouse gases with \$4 million grant program

SAN FRANCISCO - The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is conducting a workshop today to provide assistance to potential grant applicants for its greenhouse gas reduction grant program.

Up to \$4 million is available for energy efficiency, cool roof and renewable energy projects in non-residential public, government buildings located in Rodeo, Crockett, Hercules and Pinole. The deadline for submitting proposals is 5 p.m. on Monday, November 16, 2009. Funding for this program was made available by a Carbon Offset Fund created by the Air District with funds from a settlement agreement between the Attorney General of California and ConocoPhillips Company.
