HEALTH ADVISORY: UNHEALTHY AIR QUALITY IN LIVERMORE VALLEY

SAN FRANCISCO – The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is declaring a health advisory for the Livermore Valley area this afternoon due to unhealthy levels of smog.

Air quality unexpectedly reached unhealthy levels in the Livermore Valley area this afternoon at 2 p.m. and has improved but may remain in the unhealthy for sensitive groups category until this evening.

High levels of ozone pollution are particularly harmful for young children, seniors and those with respiratory and heart conditions.
