The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (District) will conduct an Industry Compliance School to present and discuss new amendments to **Regulation 8, Rule 32: Wood Products Coatings**. The Industry Compliance School is free and will be held on Tuesday, May 11, 2010 from 4:00pm to 6:00pm at the District Office located at 939 Ellis Street, San Francisco, CA 94109, in the 2nd Floor Training room.

BACKGROUND

The District amended Regulation 8, Rule 32 on August 5, 2009 to reduce volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions from wood products coatings by incorporating lower VOC limits and clarifying operational standards. These changes become effective July 1, 2010.

INDUSTRY COMPLIANCE SCHOOL DISCUSSION

District staff will review the changes to Regulation 8, Rule 32 as they apply to wood products coating operations:

- Overview of new VOC limits for coatings and solvents
- Explanation of existing exemptions
- Information requirements for coating manufacturers
- Lessons learned from transition to low VOC coatings
- Lessons learned from transition to water-based coatings.
