

**NOTICE TO PERSONS INTERESTED IN “PREVENTION OF SIGNIFICANT
DETERIORATION” PERMIT ISSUES**

Notice is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District) is maintaining a list of persons who would like to receive written notice of events relating to Prevention of Significant Deterioration (“PSD”) permits that the Air District may issue. PSD Permits are federal air pollution permits issued by the Air District under the federal Clean Air Act for facilities that emit more than certain threshold amounts of certain regulated air pollutants. When the Air District proposes to issue a PSD permit, it publishes a draft of the permit and invites members of the public to comment on it. The Air District also publishes a notice when it has scheduled a public hearing on a draft PSD permit, when it proposes to deny a PSD permit, and when an administrative appeal of a PSD permit has been granted.
