

Policy: Source Specific Regulation 8 Operation Defaulting to Regulation 8 Rule 2 or Rule 4

Policy A source/operation that is exempt from the provisions of a specific Regulation 8 rule defaults to Regulation 8, Rule 2 or 4 if all of the following are true:

- The source/operation is exempt from all provisions of the specific Regulation 8 rule,
- The rule description specifically defaults such a source/operation to Regulation 8, Rule 2 or 4,
- The source is exempt from all provisions of the specific Regulation 8 rule, provided the exemption does not specify another rule that is applicable.

Effective Date June 8, 1994

Rationale Prior to this policy, there was inconsistent interpretation whenever a source is exempt from a specific Regulation 8 rule and whether the source then defaults to Regulation 8, Rule 2 or Rule 4.

Examples (more on next page) The following are examples of how this policy is applied.

If ...	Meets the exemption in ...	Then ...
A miscellaneous metal parts coating operation	Section 8-19-112, Touch up	Regulation 8-4 applies, operation is exempt from all provision of 8-19 and no other source specific regulation applies and Regulation 8-19 description defaults operation to Regulation 8-4.
A miscellaneous metal parts coating operation	Section 8-19-110, low usage coating	Regulation 8-19 applies. The operation is subject to the low usage petition requirement in Regulation 8-19-405.

If ...	Meets the exemption in ...	Then ...
A storage tank for organic liquids	Section 8-5-117, low vapor pressure	No other Regulation 8 rule applies, and the source is in compliance with Regulation 8-5.
A wood coating operation	Section 8-32-111, Small Coating Operation	Regulation 8-32 applies, and the operation has no requirements. No other source specific rule applies. Regulation 8-32 description does not default operation to 8-4.
