The Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing to issue a Federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Permit for the proposed **Russell City Energy Center**. The proposed Russell City Energy Center is a 600-megawatt natural gas fired combined-cycle power plant that would be located at **3862 Depot Rd., near the corner of Depot Rd. and Cabot Blvd., in Hayward, CA.**

The District is seeking input from the public on this proposed permit. The public is invited to submit written comments to the District, and also to comment in person at the public hearing.
