Dear Mr. Lee,

The Russell City Energy Center will destroy our community. It is critical that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District lives up to its mission and NOT issue a Federal Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Permit for the Russell City Energy Center. Chabot College is a short distance from the proposed site, and the nearly 25,000 students who attend the college each year will be negatively impacted by emissions from the power plant. In fact, Chabot College is the "maximum impacted receptor center" for the falling pollutants from the power plant.

The California Energy Commission's own independent staff made the assessment that the proposed Russell City Energy Center not be built. Unfortunately, the energy commissioners did not listen to their own staff about the significant adverse impact the power plant will have on the community.

Please have the courage to not issue the PSD Permit, and to help save our community.
