Subject: Submittal of Application for Authority to Construct – Marsh Landing Generating Station

Dear Mr. Bateman:

Mirant Marsh Landing LLC, an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Mirant Corporation (“Mirant”) proposes to build a nominally rated 930 (approximate) net megawatt (MW) combined cycle and simple cycle power generation project within Mirant’s Contra Costa Power Plant near Antioch, California. The attached document is an Authority to Construct / Permit to Operate Application to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) for the Marsh Landing Generating Station (MLGS).

The new MLGS will be a state-of-the-art power plant including two-275MW quick start combined cycle (Siemens FlexPlant10) units using “dry” cooling technology for its operation and two-190MW quick-start simple cycle Siemens 5000F gas turbines. The MLGS will utilize the best available technology for environmental performance.

An Application for Certification for this project was filed with the California Energy Commission on May 30, 2008 (Docket # 08-AFC-3).

The enclosed application includes completed BAAQMD forms and supporting information, as well as a DVD containing electronic copies of air quality and public health modeling input and output files. A check for the permit application fees is also enclosed (check #7001245 in the amount of \$582,196).
