Kathleen –

NFPA 85 is in the process of being revised to allow "Purge Credit" as proposed by GE for the Oakley Generating Station. GE has a representative serving on the NFPA technical committees for Fundamentals of Combustion Systems Hazards (BCS-FUN) and Heat Recovery Steam Generators (BCS-HRS). NFPA has published NFPA 85 as modified through the Proposal and Comment phases of the update cycle. The following web-link can be used to track the progress of the proposed revisions to NFPA 85 <http://www.nfpa.org/aboutthecodes/AboutTheCodes.asp?DocNum=85>. If you click the "Next Edition" tab, you can download the Report on Proposal (ROP) and Report on Comments (ROC); the ROC being the most recent document (and attached to this E-mail). This document shows the proposed revisions. As indicated at the bottom of the web page, the closing date for filing a Notice of Intent to Make a Motion (NITMAM) was October 22, 2010. On November 19, 2010, we should be able to determine if anyone has filed a NITMAN. If no NITMAM was filed, the final document should be published as proposed in January 2011. If a NITMAM was filed, the content of the NITMAM will be discussed at the annual membership meeting in June 2011 and whatever is decided at that meeting will drive what is published in August 2011.
