

NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has made a preliminary decision to issue a Synthetic Minor Operating Permit to Syar industries Inc., located at 2301 Napa Vallejo Highway, Napa, CA 94558, as requested under application number 23532.

The proposed permit will impose quantifiable and practically enforceable permit conditions that limit the facility's potential to emit nitrogen oxides, volatile organic compounds, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, and particulate matter (PM10) to 95 tons per year each and greenhouse gases to 90,000 tons per year on a carbon dioxide equivalent basis. The permit will also limit the facility's potential to emit hazardous air pollutants to 9 tons per year of any single hazardous air pollutant and 23 tons per year of any combination of hazardous air pollutants. By limiting the facility's potential to emit in this manner, the proposed permit will ensure that the facility remains exempt from the requirements of the Federal Operating Permit Program as codified in Title V of the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.

The Air Pollution Control Officer invites written public comment on the above application and intended action. Comments must be submitted by June 18, 2012.
