NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is reopening the Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The facility above received its initial Title V permit on December 1, 2003. On December 15, 2003, the facility was given notice that the permit would be reopened to finalize flare conditions, finalize monitoring for Regulation 9, Rule 10, limits, to incorporate authorities to construct that have been identified by the facility as “critical”, and to incorporate other corrections. All changes are clearly shown in “strikeout/underline format” and have been addressed in the permit evaluation/statement of basis. The District invites comments on these changes.

The proposed revisions include permit modifications made in three District permit applications. The potential increase of criteria pollutant emissions for each of these applications is summarized as follows and all these emission increases have been offset at a ratio of 1.0 to 1.15 in compliance with BAAQMD Regulation 2, Rule 2:

The District also invites comments on changes made to the draft permit published on September 12, 2003, as reflected in the final permit issued on December 1, 2003. Comments made on other aspects of the permit will be accepted but may not be addressed at this time. All comments must be received by March 31, 2004. The public may also request a public hearing for this draft revision of the permit.

After the public comment period and after any changes made in response to comments, a proposed revised permit will be sent to US EPA for their 45-day review. The public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105 within 60 days after the end of US EPA’s review to object to the permit.
