The purpose of the reopening of the Title V permit addresses permit deficiencies identified by the EPA on October 8, 2004 and EPA's order of March 15, 2005. The reopening also incorporates changes in applicable requirements authorized in an Authority to Construct and addresses issues raised in the refinery's appeals and comments. In addition, Application numbers 13570 and 14308 were also included to cleanup errors in the NOx Box conditions and to subject some sources to NSPS subparts A and J. Please see the enclosed Statement of Basis reports for the reopening revisions 2.0 and 3.0 for further detail.
