The minor revisions will allow S36 and S461, Heaters, to operate without SCR for brief periods as long as the NOx limits are met and to add a schedule of compliance to the permit for alternative Subpart J monitoring at these sources. The significant revisions will allow total sulfur monitoring to be used as a surrogate for TRS monitoring on a permanent basis, with periodic checks of the ratio of TRS to total sulfur in fuel, and will allow a throughput increase at S437/S438, Hydrogen Plant.
