The District has completed its evaluation of the renewal of the Major Facility Review Permit for the following facility:

The District has made a preliminary decision to issue the renewal Major Facility Review Permit, but the final decision on the permit issuance will consider public and EPA comments on the draft permit. The notice inviting written public comments will be published in the West County Times. The final date for comments is April 14, 2011.

In addition to the renewal application (18231), the following applications are included in this action: 14601, 14856, 14857, 14963, 15442, 17052, 19361, 19626, 20802, 21295, and 21343.

The initial Title V permit for this facility was issued on December 1, 2003. Details of the previous revisions can be found in Section X of the permit "Revision History". All changes to the most recent version of the permit are clearly shown in ~~strikeout~~/underline format.

After the District has considered all public comments and made any necessary changes, the permit will be submitted to EPA for review.
