The purpose of the revisions is to:

- Incorporate the flare provisions of the consent decree entered against ConocoPhillips by the US District Court for the Southern District of Texas on January 27, 2005.
- Incorporate changes made to the POC monitoring for the cooling towers.
- Lower the capacity of S3, Heater.
- Allow unlimited throughput of low-volatility materials at S448, Internal Floating Roof Tank.
- Delete Federal and state greenhouse gas reporting requirements.
- Add temperature limits to A49 and A424, Thermal Oxidizers

In addition to the changes above, the following administrative amendments will be made to the permit:

- The name of the facility will be changed at the applicant's request.
- The Section VII table for S45, which was dropped in error, will be added.
- Condition 1694, part A.6, Condition 22964, parts 2, 3, 8, and 9, and Condition 22122, part 6, dropped in error, will be added.
- Source S1001 and abatement devices A1 and A421 will be deleted from the permit.
- Duplicate Table VII-U will be deleted.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.
