The purpose of this minor revision is to allow an increase in the throughput of crude oil and gas oil at the marine terminal and at five tanks and to add the value of the temperature parameter at A49, DAF Thermal Oxidizer, and A424, SRU Oxidizer.

Also, Part 4 of Condition 22964, deleted in error, has been reinstated in the permit. The reinstatement of the permit condition is the correction of an error and is therefore an administrative amendment. Several other administrative amendments have been included in this minor revision. A summary of these amendments is attached.

Additional Administrative Amendments

1. The District proposed to delete S464, Hydrogen Plant, from the equipment list in the Major Facility Review permit in the proposal of August 27, 2013. The following additional references to S464 have been deleted. Deletion of sources is defined as an administrative amendment in BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-201.
 - a. A50, Hydrogen Plant Scrubber, the control device for S464, has been deleted.
 - b. Mention of S464 has been deleted from Tables IV-Nc, IV-Components, and VII-Nc.
 - c. Condition 6671, which applied to S464 and A50, has been deleted.
 - d. S464 was deleted from Condition 20989.

2. The notes in Table II-A, Equipment, stating that the following sources did not have final District permits, have been deleted. These sources now have final permits. The notes in Table II-A stated that the notes would be removed using administrative amendment procedures.
 - a. S98, S168, S173, S174, S175, Tanks
 - b. S434, U246 High Pressure Reactor Train
 - b. S503, Sulfur Storage Tank
 - c. S504, Sulfur Degassing
 - d. S505, Sulfur Truck Loading Rack
