The purpose of this permit revision is to incorporate revisions associated with a consent decree (Title V application 24692) and condition changes that were issued under NSR applications 25621 (TV 25622) and 26020 (TV 26021). The revision also includes two administrative amendments to the Title V permit. Condition 23125, part 13 has been corrected to reference A-424 instead of S-424 and condition 23125, part 15 has been corrected to reference A-424 instead of A-48.

The EPA review period ended on July 2, 2014. We did not receive any comments on the proposed minor revision from EPA, ARB, or the facility.
