The District previously held a public hearing on the initial draft Title V permit renewal for the Lehigh facility, and is not planning on holding a second hearing. Comments on the revised draft permit should be submitted in writing by March 25. If you have any questions on the draft permit or Statement of Basis that you would like answered prior to making any comments, please feel free to call (or e-mail) me. If you would like, we could always meet and discuss as well.

It is important to note that our regulations require that Title V permits be issued by the District's Air Pollution Control Officer (APCO), and not the elected officials that serve on the District's Board of Directors. Requests for public hearings should be made to myself, and I will forward them to the APCO for consideration.
