Dear Ms. Bui,

At BAAQMD's public meeting on September 17, 2009 concerning subject permit renewal, I would like someone from the BAAQMD to comment on four items contained in your January 2, 2009 FACT SHEET which is found at your website.

The four items are as follows:

- 1.) Why does your public announcement say that Title V permits must be renewed every 5 years when the FACT SHEET says they are asking for a 25 year renewal?
- 2.) EPA has not yet finalized their review of the fuel change project to see if it triggers federal PSD permit requirements. Why doesn't the BAAQMD defer permit issuance until their review has been completed?
- 3.) In November 2008, BAAQMD started an ambient air monitor to continuously record particulate matter levels in the air. Please present the results-to-date for this monitoring.
- 4.) If Santa Clara County has indicated that the Hanson Quarry Reclamation Plan Amendment is on hold pending additional geologic studies. why is BAAQMD considering a permit renewal at this time?

Item 3 is of particular importance to me as I can see the dust generated from that plant on a daily basis at my house on Redwood Drive.

In the interest of full disclosure, it is imperative that BAAQMD address these items at the public meeting on September 17, 2009.
