I am very concerned about the emissions from the plant; both carbon dioxide and mercury from the plant are polluting the air in cupertino and the surrounding communities. I am especially disappointed to see the the American Lung Association has given Santa Clara county an F rating for air quality and feel that the cement plant has contributed significantly to this dismal grade. This is a public health issue that can be addressed and I ask that before renewal of the Title V Permit, regulations of emissions from the plant be put in place.
