NRG Delta, LLC, Contra Costa Generating Station was subject to Title V because it operated two large boilers that had the potential to emit more than 100 tons per year of carbon monoxide and nitrogen oxides.

According to a letter dated August 30, 2013, from Michael Montany of NRG, those boilers were permanently taken out of service as of May 1, 2013. Therefore, the facility's potential to emit no longer exceeds any major source thresholds and is no longer subject to Title V permit requirements.
