Mr. Lusher,

The purpose of this letter is to request the cancellation of the Major Facility Review (Title V) permit for NRG Delta, LLC, Contra Costa Generating Station (Facility #A0018).


As you know, the electric generating units at Contra Costa Generating Station (CCGS) have been permanently retired, effective May 1, 2013. We have submitted Retired Unit Exemption forms for both Boiler 9 and Boiler 10 with USEPA Headquarters, and therefore the CCGS is no longer an acid rain facility. Copies of the Retired Unit Exemption forms are enclosed.

With the retirement of Boiler 9 (Source 9) and Boiler 10 (Source 10), the facility no longer has the potential to emit 100 tons per year or more of any regulated air pollutant, nor does the facility have the potential to emit 10 tons per year or more of a single hazardous air pollutant or 25 tons per year or more of a combination of hazardous air pollutants. Therefore, the facility no longer meets the definition of a Major Facility in accordance with District Regulation 2-6-212, and we respectively request the cancellation of the Major Facility Review permit for Facility # A0018.
