Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is modifying the proposal for administrative permit amendments and minor modifications to the Major Facility Review Permit for Owens-Brockway Glass Container (Facility Number A0030).

In addition to the changes proposed on July 11, 2000, the following changes are proposed:

1. Owens-Brockway has submitted a written request for an extension of the deadline for the installation of the NOx CEM at S10, Glass Furnace, until December 1, 2000 because the vendor requires more time to complete the installation. We believe that this is not a substantive change.
2. Based on comments from the District's legal staff, a new condition has been added to Section I of the Permit. Condition I.J reads: "The maximum capacity for each source as shown in Table II-A is the maximum allowable capacity. Exceedance of the maximum allowable capacity for any source is a violation of Regulation 2, Rule 1, Section 301. (Regulation 2-1-301)". A note has also been added to Table II.A, Equipment List, that refers to this standard condition. This change is not substantive because it simply clarifies the District's position on the maximum permitted capacity of each source.

We assume that the end of the EPA review period (August 28, 2000) will not change due to these modifications. Please let us know if we are mistaken.
