This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is issuing a significant revision and a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Redwood Landfill, Inc. (Facility #A1179).

The District proposed a significant permit revision for this facility on August 13, 2004. The main purpose of this revision was to increase the maximum permitted firing capacity and the landfill gas throughput limits for the A-50 Landfill Gas Flare. The District also made several corrections to applicable requirements tables, removed future effective dates that have passed, and deleted several unnecessary limits. This significant revision resulted in the following emission increases: 13.2 tons/year of CO, 3.5 tons/year of SO₂, 3.0 tons/year of POC, 2.6 tons/year of NO_x, and 0.3 tons/year of PM₁₀.

Subsequently, the District proposed a minor permit revision for this facility on September 13, 2004. The purpose of this revision was to update the landfill gas collection system description and to authorize the installation of additional wells, which are necessary to ensure compliance with Regulation 8, Rule 34. This minor revision resulted in no emission increases.
