

NOTICE INVITING WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENTS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District invites interested persons to submit written public comments on the proposed Significant Revision to a Major Facility Review Permit for the following Facility:

The purpose of this revision is to increase the maximum permitted landfill gas sulfur content for landfill gas from the S-5 Redwood Landfill and to increase the maximum permitted sulfur dioxide emission rate from the A-50 Landfill Gas Flare. This application will result in 24.07 tons/year of SO₂ emission increases. After this modification, the landfill and flare will emit 2.65 tons/year of hydrogen sulfide (not a HAP) and 0.03 tons/year of carbon disulfide (a HAP). Based on a case-by-case RACT determination, the flare will comply with RACT for SO₂ emissions. MACT does not apply. Emission reduction credits will not be required.

The Executive Officer/Air Pollution Control Officer invites written comment on the above proposed significant revision. Comments must be received by May 16, 2005. The public may also request a public hearing for this significant revision.

Significant revisions of Major Facility Review Permits are also subject to review and approval by US EPA. If US EPA has not objected to a proposed significant revision and District has not addressed a public comment in a satisfactory manner, the public may petition US EPA, Region IX, Operating Permits Section at 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105, within 60 days after the end of US EPA's review, to reconsider the issuance of the permit.
