This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is issuing a significant revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Redwood Landfill, Inc. (Facility # A1179) pursuant to Applications # 10873 and # 10874.

The District proposed a significant permit revision for this facility on April 12, 2005. The purpose of this revision is to increase the maximum permitted landfill gas sulfur content for landfill gas from the S-5 Redwood Landfill and to increase the maximum permitted sulfur dioxide emission rate from the A-50 Landfill Gas Flare.

No comments on this proposed significant revision were received from the public or the facility. During the EPA comment period, EPA made a verbal comment that the emission calculations for this project were not correct. The District reviewed the emission calculations and did find errors in these calculations. The correct proposed emissions for the S-5 Redwood Landfill and A-50 Landfill Gas Flare are 52.4 tons/year of SO₂, 7.15 tons/year of H₂S, and 0.02 tons/year of CS₂, and the correct emission increases are 32.4 tons/year of SO₂, 5.79 tons/year of H₂S, and 0.02 tons/year of CS₂. However, these corrections to the emission calculations do not change the proposed permit conditions nor any of the conclusions discussed in the Evaluation Report. Based on a case-by-case RACT determination, the flare will comply with RACT for SO₂ emissions. MACT does not apply. Emission reduction credits will not be required because facility wide SO₂ emissions will be less than 100 tons/year.
