The main purpose of this proposed permit revision is to add the new A-51 Landfill Gas Flare. Since the combined landfill gas throughput rate to the existing A-50 flare and new A-51 flare will be the same as the current limit for A-50, this proposal will not result in any cumulative emission increases. In addition to adding A-51, the District is proposing to clarify several permit conditions concerning operating requirements for landfill gas control systems and reporting requirements for landfill gas sulfur content limits and tests. The District is also proposing to update regulatory amendment dates in Section IV and add two terms to the glossary.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.

A copy of the proposed revisions to the Major Facility Review Permit, the statement of basis report for Application Number 11948, and the engineering evaluations for Application Numbers 11757 and 12003 are enclosed for your review.
