On July 13, 2006, the District proposed a minor permit revision for this facility. The main purpose of this revision was to add two sources (S-56 Portable Horizontal Grinder and S-58 Aerated Leachate Pond) to the MFR Permit for this facility. This revision increased the facility wide potential to emit by 10.0 tons of PM₁₀ per year due to S-56 and by 0.08 tons of POC per year due to S-58. Offsets were supplied for the POC emission increases.

The EPA comment period ended on August 28, 2006. No comments were received from EPA.

The District has decided to issue the revised permit incorporating the proposed minor revision. Enclosed is a copy of the final revised permit. If you have any questions regarding this permit, please call Dennis Jang, Senior Air Quality Engineer, at: (415) 749-4707.
