This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for the Kirby Canyon Landfill, Site Number A1812. The purpose of this revision is to update the Title V permit to reflect recent District permitting activity and proposed permitting activity. The additions of equipment to the permit will increase emissions at the facility as follows:
