Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill, Inc., Facility Number A1840, and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The main purpose of this proposed permit revision is to add the S-46 Hazardous Waste Management Facility (HWMF), the proposed gas collection system (19 horizontal collectors) for S-46, and the proposed control system (A-11 Landfill Gas Flare for HWMF), which were permitted pursuant to Applications # 2789 and # 8514. The emissions from S-46 after control by A-11 are 1.72 tons/year of POC. The secondary emissions from A-11 are 6.86 tons/year of CO, 1.37 tons/year of NO_x, 1.14 tons/year of SO₂, 0.39 tons/year of PM₁₀. NO_x and POC emission increases were offset by excess contemporaneous on-site emission reductions generated from the replacement of a landfill gas fired IC engine pursuant to Application # 27193. In addition to adding S-46 and A-11, the District is proposing to correct several errors, update regulatory amendment dates, include non-federally enforceable requirements, and clarify conditions.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.

A copy of the proposed revisions to the Major Facility Review Permit, the statement of basis report, and the engineering evaluations for Application Numbers 2789 and 8514 are enclosed for your review. This letter, the statement of basis report, and the engineering evaluations constitute the statement of basis for this minor permit revision.
