Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Waste Management of Alameda County, Facility Number A2066, and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The purpose of this permit revision is to modify the minimum combustion chamber discharge temperature limit for two landfill gas fired gas turbines, because January 2004 source test data indicates that the turbines will comply with the Regulation 8-34-301.4 NMOC emission limit at a lower temperature. This revision will not result in any emission increases.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.

A copy of the proposed revisions to the Major Facility Review Permit and the engineering evaluation for Application #9326 are enclosed for your review and comment. This letter and the engineering evaluation constitute the statement of basis for this minor permit revision.
