This is to inform you of the cancellation of the Major Facility Review (Title V) permit for City of Santa Clara.

The District issued the initial Title V permit on March 6, 2003. The facility was required to obtain a Title V permit since it was a "designated facility" under the provisions of 40 CFR 60.32(c) as a landfill with a "design capacity of 2.5 million mega grams or more, or a landfill with a design capacity of 2.5 million cubic meters or more". On August 31, 2007, the facility submitted an application to renew the Title V permit. This facility is now a closed landfill, and meets the all of the requirements set out for removal of a landfill from Title V permitting under 40 CFR 60.762(b). Accordingly, the District issued a synthetic minor permit to the facility on September 7, 2011. The proposed synthetic minor permit was subjected to EPA, ARB, and public review and comment prior to issuance.

Because City of Santa Clara is no longer subject to Major Facility Review, we are canceling the Title V permit.

The cancellation of the Title V permit is effective as of the date of this letter.
