Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to inform you of the cancellation of the Major Facility Review (Title V) permit for Napa-Vallejo Waste Management Authority.

The District issued the initial Title V permit on December 19, 2003. The facility was required to obtain a Title V permit since it was a "designated facility" under the provisions of 40 CFR 60.32(c) as a landfill with a "design capacity of 2.5 million mega grams or more, or a landfill with a design capacity of 2.5 million cubic meters or more". On May 30, 2008, the facility submitted an application to renew the Title V permit. This facility is now a closed landfill, and meets the all of the requirements set out for removal of a landfill from Title V permitting under 40 CFR 60.762(b). Accordingly, the District issued a synthetic minor permit to the facility on January 17, 2012. The proposed synthetic minor permit was subjected to EPA, ARB, and public review and comment prior to issuance. No comments were received on the public notice; however, a local journalist called for additional information, and was directed to the engineering evaluation on the District website.

Because Napa-Vallejo Waste Management Authority is no longer subject to Major Facility Review, we are canceling the Title V permit. The cancellation of the Title V permit is effective as of the date of this letter.

The District will also notify the California Air Resources Board and the facility in writing of this permit action.
