 - Condition 4 should be clarified to clearly indicate that S-101 and S-102 are subject to 30 ppm limit imposed by Reg 9-7-301.1 instead of the 40 ppm limit referenced in the Condition.
 - Delete last sentence of Condition 9b dry low NOx burners are already in service
- Table VII-B: remove references to Condition 2780 parts 1a(i) and 1e conditions are no longer applicable since dry low NOx burners already in operation
- Acid Rain Permit: Change Facility Contact Person from Michael Fees to Lance Null, Plant Engineer, (408) 337-3430.
