Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing a minor revision to the Major Facility Review Permit for Calpine Gilroy Cogen, LP & Gilroy Energy Center, LLC and is submitting the permit to EPA for review.

The purpose of this minor permit revision is to install new dry low NOx combustors on S-100 to meet Regulation 9, Rule 9 requirements. This revision also amends the emission unit's PSD conditions, which required water injection for NOx control. The amendments are considered administrative amendments for the purposes of PSD in accordance with the 1985 EPA policy memo by Darryl D. Tyler entitled "Revised Draft Policy on Permit Modifications and Extensions." The details are in the permit evaluation for District Application 18434, which is attached to the Statement of Basis for this application.

This revision is minor pursuant to BAAQMD Regulation 2-6-215 and will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.
