The purpose of this amendment is to add non-federally enforceable permit conditions to S-101 and S-102 auxiliary boilers to ensure compliance with Regulation 9, Rule 7 requirements. The facility retrofitted each auxiliary boiler with an SCR. The SCR units were added to Table II-B. Condition 25512 was added to Table IV-C. In Table VII-C, references to 9-7-307.6 were updated. The NOx limit, ammonia limit, and hour of operation limits contained in condition 25512 were also added to Table VII-C.

Administrative amendments do not require EPA review and are effective upon issuance.
