The purpose of the minor permit revision is to modify existing permit conditions for Source S5 Turbine, one of six 27.5 MW (365 MMBtu/hr) distillate oil-fired gas turbines (S1-S6) at this peaking power plant located in Oakland. These condition revisions will allow Dynegey to conduct performance and emissions testing of biofuel blends at the S-5 Turbine. The District is proposing to issue a conditional Temporary Permit to Operate (TPO), valid for 3 months after issuance, to Dynegey for biofuel testing. Condition revisions and the TPO conditions will be eliminated upon expiration of the TPO. These actions are not expected to result in any emission increases.

The administrative amendment and proposed minor revision will be effective immediately. The permit will be formally re-issued after EPA review. This revision is not subject to public comment and therefore, requires no public notice.
