The final Title V permit and statements of basis can be viewed on the District website at http://www.baaqmd.gov/pmt/title_v/public_notices.htm.

This reopening of the Title V permit addresses permit deficiencies identified by the EPA on October 8, 2004 and EPA's order of March 15, 2005. In addition, minor revisions for the following applications are incorporated: Applications 10355, 10665/10692, 11017/11018, 11307, 12578, 12588/12589, 12434/12701, 12659/12478, 12867 and 12575.

Public notices were published on April 21, 2005 and August 9, 2005. The public notice period for Application 11697 ended on May 24, 2005; the public notice period for Application 12600 ended on September 22, 2005.

The permit was proposed to EPA on November 1, 2006. The review period ended on December 15, 2006. EPA offered no comments on the permit. However, consistent with ongoing discussions regarding flare monitoring and NSPS Subpart J, the language in the Statement of Basis, Rev. 3, Section C., Part IV (G.) on page 11 was revised.
