This is to inform you that the District is formally proposing the renewal Major Facility Review permit for the facility listed below to EPA for its 45-day review period:

The District has made a preliminary decision to issue the renewal Major Facility Review Permit, but the final decision on the permit issuance will consider EPA comments on the proposed permit.

The District published a notice inviting written public comment on the draft renewal Major Facility Review permit on May 26, 2010 in the Contra Costa Times newspaper. The comment period ended on July 14, 2010. No comments were received from the public. The facility submitted 321 comments. In response to Tesoro's comments, the District made several changes to the public noticed version of the permit. The changes are shown in the District's Response to Comments.

The District removed the 40 CFR Part 60, Subpart A, Section 60.18 requirement from various tables in Section IV. This change is based on the applicability determination included in the Statement of Basis (page 41). The facility and an industry association commented and explained why this requirement should not apply, and the District agrees with this position.

The initial Title V permit for this facility was issued on December 1, 2003. Details of the previous revisions can be found in Section X of the permit "Revision History". All changes to the most recent version of the permit are clearly shown in strikeout/underline format.
