Dear Ms. Jordan:

This is to advise you that the Bay Area Air Quality Management District is proposing significant and minor revisions to the Major Facility Review Permit for ConocoPhillips – San Francisco Refinery (Facility Number A0016 and Facility Number A0022), and an initial Major Facility Review Permit for Facility B7419. These revisions and initial permit are being proposed together because they represent one project.

The purpose of this action is to add the Clean Fuels Expansion Project to the Title V permits and to make some additional changes. The CFEP consists of a new hydrogen plant, sulfur recovery unit, and hydrocracking capacity. The pre-construction review applications were 13424, 13678, and 15328. The minor tank changes made in Applications 16941, 18744, and 18747 are also being proposed in this action. In addition, this action resolves the remaining items on the appeal that was submitted to the District pursuant to the initial Title V permit in 2003.

The District is inviting public comment on the significant revisions. The notice inviting written public comment will be published in the West County Times. The final date for comments is May 25, 2009.
